



PACE PROMISE REQUIREMENTS

\$1,000 scholarship for up to four years to attend California State University, San Marcos

- ❑ Attend SMUSD schools from 9th - 12th grade
- ❑ Complete all A-G coursework with "C" or better
- ❑ Meet CSU Eligibility Index <https://www2.calstate.edu/apply/eligibility-index>
- ❑ Demonstrate readiness for college level work*

This requirement can be satisfied in **one of** the following ways:

1. 11th grade CAASPP Early Assessment Program (EAP) status of "Standard Exceeded" (Level 4). These scores can be found on your CAASPP report www.caaspp.org
2. CAASPP EAP status of "Standard Met" (Level 3) means you are "Conditionally Ready" and you must:
 - a. Math- must be enrolled in a senior year math course with a prerequisite of Algebra 2 or higher and earn a grade of "C" or better both semesters
 - b. English- must be enrolled in a senior year English course and earn a grade of "C" or better.
3. Scores of at least 500 in English, and 550 in math on the SAT, or
4. Scores of 22 in English and 23 in math on the ACT, or
5. Score of 3 or above in Advanced Placement English or Math

Deadline: March 2, 2018

- ❑ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) <https://fafsa.ed.gov> or California Dream Act Application <https://dream.csac.ca.gov/>
- ❑ Complete TSMP Scholar Application (<http://thesanmarcospromise.org>)
- ❑ Complete EVERFI "FinLit" financial literacy online course.
