Deadline: March 2, 2018

- Apply for **Admission** (www.palomar.edu)
Select "HS graduate," NOT "HS student"
- Apply for **FAFSA** or **DREAM ACT** (www.fafsa.gov or dream.csac.ca.gov)
Add Palomar College (001260) for your college
- Apply for **First Year Experience (FYE) Program** (lower right of the Student Center screen)

To qualify for Palomar Promise+ (year 2 funding)

Deadline: March 2, 2018

- Complete TSMP Scholar Application (<http://thesanmarcospromise.org>)
- Complete EVERFI financial literacy online course

Additional Requirements (upon graduation)

- Graduate high school with a 2.5 GPA
- "College Ready" in Math, Reading and English upon high school graduation

OTHER STEPS TO COMPLETE (before you will be able to enroll in classes)

- Submit your final high school transcript to Palomar College by July 1, 2018
- Complete Orientation at Palomar College or online
- Complete an Educational Plan with a Palomar College counselor

Assessment- The English, Reading and Math placement results are based on the information you provide on the Palomar College application for admission. Find results on eServices student portal (bottom right corner of the Student Center page)

Registration for Fall 2018 is from June 1 – June 21 – must register for 12 units and complete financial aid to do list

Tuition- FREE up to 19 units/semester

Parking- Parking permit for fall and spring

Books- \$350 for Fall 2018 and \$350 for Spring 2019 terms (\$700 max for the year)
